### Guidelines for Cookie Exchange Participation

- Each participant must provide 7 dozen of one cookie recipe: 2 dozen on a plate for tasting and judging during the event and 5 dozen individually packaged in plastic baggie for easy swapping.
- All entries must arrive at St. Patrick Church before the event on December 15th, to qualify for judging and prizes. Drop off times are 8:30 a.m.-4 p.m. (closed noon -1:30 p.m. for lunch). If anyone needs to drop cookies off earlier than the time stated, please contact us to make arrangements.
- Participants should be 12 years of age or older (Sorry, no child-care is provided.).
- If you don't have time to bake, ruin or completely forget your cookies, but still want to participate, you must go to a real bakery and buy 7 dozen cookies.
- Participants do not have to share their recipes but **ingredients must be listed to alert those with allergies**.
- No refrigerated cookies or no-bake cookies will be accepted.
- Prizes will be awarded in the following categories: Best Tasting, Best Design, and Best Overall. There will also be door prizes.
